

How to Make a Memory Box Station



Materials

Display Poster: Memory Box Directions

Display Poster: Outside Brain

Display Poster: Inside Brain

Two boxes or lunch trays draped with towels to hide contents.

One set of related objects (for example: yo-yo, rock, ribbon, can, leaf, magnet, key, paintbrush)

One set of related objects (for example, pencil, tape, notepad, protractor, ruler, eraser)

Optional: Display Frames

What to Do

Put random objects into one box and label it Box #1. Put related objects into a boxed labeled Box #2. Close the boxes and you are ready to try this station.
